

Petition for Restoration

The Petition For Restoration is the form used for former members who wished to return to the Masonic Order who is not on EXPULSION from the Lodge.

Any member who has been out of the order for more than 90 Ninety Days Must Petition the Lodge for Restoration.

If accepted by the Lodge, the form is sent to the Grand Secretary with the appropriate fees.

A “**Certificate of Restoration**” will be issued by the Grand Secretary. **NOTE (Only then is the brother considered on the rolls.)**

RETURNING AFTER 90 DAYS OR LESS

- Pay all in debt ness to the lodge

RETURNING AFTER 91 DAYS TO 5 YEARS

- Pay 3 months dues plus any in debt ness to lodge
- Pay \$ 50.00 to Grand lodge
- Pay \$ 5.00 to Grand Master

RETURNING AFTER 2 YEARS UNDER RELIEF

- Pay 3 months dues plus any in debt ness to lodge
- Pay \$ 50.00 to Grand lodge
- Pay \$ 5.00 to Grand Master
- ***Must pay (6) Six quarters to Relief Department***

RETURNING AS NON RELIEF

Pay 3 months dues plus any in debt ness to lodge

- Pay \$ 50.00 to Grand lodge
- Pay \$ 5.00 to Grand Master

Submit request for Restoration with the appropriate fee to the Grand Secretary. **A Certificate of Restoration** will be issued. **(He is not a member until the certificate is received.)**
